Section 321.013, Government Code, is amended by 19 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (k-1) to read as 20 21 follows: 22 (a) The State Auditor shall conduct audits of all departments, including of institutions of higher education and of 23 open-enrollment charter schools that annually receive more than 24

1 <u>\$100 million in state revenue</u>, as specified in the audit plan. At 2 the direction of the committee, the State Auditor shall conduct an 3 audit or investigation of any entity receiving funds from the 4 state.

(k-1) In devising the audit plan under Subsection (c), the 5 6 State Auditor shall consider the performance of audits on open-enrollment charter schools that annually receive more than 7 \$100 million in state revenue. The State Auditor may collaborate 8 9 with the State Board of Education in performing an audit under this subsection. An audit described by this subsection may be limited in 10 scope to open-enrollment charter schools that the State Auditor 11 12 determines pose the highest financial risk to this state. SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021. 13
