## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 1701, Occupations Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 1701.269 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 1701.269. TRAINING PROGRAM RELATING TO COUNTY JAILER
- 8 INTERACTIONS WITH PERSONS WITH INTELLECTUAL OR DEVELOPMENTAL
- 9 DISABILITIES. (a) The commission and the Commission on Jail
- 10 Standards shall jointly develop a training program for county
- 11 jailers that consists of at least four hours of education and
- 12 training on interacting with a person with an intellectual or
- 13 developmental disability who is confined in a county jail,
- 14 including techniques to assess a person for an intellectual or
- 15 developmental disability.
- 16 (b) A county jailer who completes the training program may
- 17 count the hours toward the jailer's continuing education
- 18 requirements under this chapter.
- 19 SECTION 2. Not later than January 1, 2022, the Texas
- 20 Commission on Law Enforcement shall develop the training program
- 21 required by Section 1701.269, Occupations Code, as added by this
- 22 Act.
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
