5	SECTION 1. Chapter 87, Education Code, is amended by adding
6	Subchapter M to read as follows:
7	SUBCHAPTER M. TEXAS A&M UNIVERSITYEAGLE PASS
8	Sec. 87.881. DEFINITIONS. In this subchapter:
9	(1) "Board" means the board of regents of The Texas A&M
10	University System.
11	(2) "University" means Texas A&M UniversityEagle
12	Pass.
13	Sec. 87.882. ESTABLISHMENT; SCOPE. (a) Texas A&M
14	UniversityEagle Pass is a general academic teaching institution
15	located in Maverick County. The university is a component
16	institution of The Texas A&M University System and is under the
17	governance, management, and control of the board of regents of The
18	Texas A&M University System.
19	(b) The board has the same powers and duties concerning
20	Texas A&M UniversityEagle Pass as are conferred on the board by
21	statute concerning Texas A&M University.
22	Sec. 87.883. COURSES AND DEGREES. (a) The board may
23	prescribe courses leading to customary degrees offered at leading
24	American universities and may award those degrees, including

1	bachelor's, master's, and doctoral degrees and their equivalents.
2	(b) The board shall award degrees in the name of the
3	university.
4	(c) A department, school, or degree program may not be
5	instituted without the prior approval of the Texas Higher Education
6	Coordinating Board.
7	Sec. 87.884. UNIVERSITY OF THE FIRST CLASS. The board shall
8	make any other rules and regulations for the operation, control,
9	and management of the university as may be necessary for the conduct
10	of the university as a university of the first class.
11	Sec. 87.885. FACILITIES. The board shall provide for
12	adequate physical facilities for use by the university.
13	Sec. 87.886. GIFTS AND GRANTS. The board may solicit,
14	accept, and administer, on terms and conditions acceptable to the
15	board, gifts, grants, or donations of any kind and from any source
16	for use by the university.
17	Sec. 87.887. AFFILIATION AGREEMENTS; JOINT APPOINTMENTS.
18	(a) The board may execute and carry out with any entity or
19	institution affiliation or coordinating agreements that are
20	reasonably necessary or desirable for the conduct and operation of
21	a university of the first class.
22	(b) The board may make joint faculty appointments to
23	positions in the university and to positions in other institutions
24	under the board's governance. The salary of a person who receives a
25	joint appointment shall be apportioned to the appointing
26	institutions on the basis of services rendered.
27	Sec. 87.888. PARTICIPATION IN PERMANENT UNIVERSITY FUND.

If the Act enacting this subchapter receives a vote of two-thirds of 1 2 the membership of each house of the legislature, the university is entitled to participate in the funding provided by Section 18, 3 Article VII, Texas Constitution, to the same extent as similar 4 component institutions of The Texas A&M University System. 5 6 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 7 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 9

10 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
