## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to a grant program for public improvement projects for
3	unincorporated communities in certain counties.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subtitle B, Title 12, Local Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Chapter 388 to read as follows:
7	CHAPTER 388. GRANT PROGRAM FOR UNINCORPORATED COMMUNITIES IN
8	CERTAIN COUNTIES
9	Sec. 388.001. APPLICABILITY. This chapter applies only to
10	a county that:
11	(1) has a population of not more than 3,000;
12	(2) is adjacent to at least three counties with
13	populations of less than 10,000; and
14	(3) is located on an international border.
15	Sec. 388.002. IMPROVEMENT PROJECT GRANT PROGRAM. (a) The
16	commissioners court of a county by order may establish and
17	implement a grant program for the purpose of funding public
18	improvement projects to benefit unincorporated communities located
19	in the county.
20	(b) A public improvement project includes:
21	(1) the acquisition, construction, or improvement of:
22	(A) sidewalks, streets, roads, or other
23	transportation infrastructure;
24	(B) water, wastewater, or drainage facilities or

- 2 (C) other public facilities or improvements; and
- 3 (2) special supplemental services for improvement and
- 4 promotion of the area, including services relating to advertising,
- 5 promotion, health and sanitation, water and wastewater, public
- 6 safety, security, business recruitment, development, recreation,
- 7 and cultural enhancement.
- 8 Sec. 388.003. GIFTS, GRANTS, AND DONATIONS. The county may
- 9 accept a gift, grant, or donation from any source to fund a public
- 10 improvement project described by Section 388.002.
- 11 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 12 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 13 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 14 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 15 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
