A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
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- 2 relating to student loan repayment assistance for certain health
- 3 care workers employed in rural counties.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 61, Education Code, is amended by adding
- 6 Subchapter L-2 to read as follows:
- 7 SUBCHAPTER L-2. REPAYMENT OF EDUCATION LOANS FOR RURAL HEALTH CARE
- 8 WORKERS
- 9 Sec. 61.691. DEFINITIONS. In this subchapter:
- 10 (1) "Health care worker" means a person who furnishes
- 11 health care services in direct patient care situations under a
- 12 license, certificate, or registration issued by this state or a
- 13 person providing direct patient care in the course of a training or
- 14 educational program.
- 15 (2) "Rural county" means a county in this state with a
- 16 population of less than 100,000.
- 17 Sec. 61.692. LOAN REPAYMENT ASSISTANCE AUTHORIZED. The
- 18 board shall provide, in accordance with this subchapter and board
- 19 rules, assistance in the repayment of eligible student loans for
- 20 eligible health care workers who apply and qualify for the
- 21 <u>assistance.</u>
- Sec. 61.693. ELIGIBILITY. To be eligible to receive loan
- 23 repayment assistance under this subchapter, a health care worker
- 24 may not be receiving loan repayment assistance under another

- 1 program administered by the board and must:
- 2 (1) apply to the board in a manner prescribed by the
- 3 board;
- 4 (2) at the time of application for repayment
- 5 assistance be employed full-time as a health care worker in a rural
- 6 county; and
- 7 (3) commit to full-time employment as a health care
- 8 worker in a rural county for not less than two years after the
- 9 health care worker receives the loan repayment lump sum under
- 10 <u>Section 61.696</u>.
- Sec. 61.694. LIMITATIONS. A health care worker may receive
- 12 loan repayment assistance under this subchapter for not more than
- 13 four years.
- Sec. 61.695. ELIGIBLE LOANS. (a) The board may provide
- 15 loan repayment assistance under this subchapter for the repayment
- 16 of any student loan for education at an institution of higher
- 17 education, a private or independent institution of higher
- 18 education, or a public or private out-of-state institution of
- 19 higher education accredited by a recognized accrediting agency,
- 20 including loans for undergraduate education, received by an
- 21 eligible person through any lender.
- 22 <u>(b) The board may not provide repayment assistance for a</u>
- 23 student loan that is in default at the time of the person's
- 24 application.
- 25 (c) In each state fiscal biennium, the board shall attempt
- 26 to allocate all funds appropriated to the board for the purpose of
- 27 providing loan repayment assistance under this subchapter.

- 1 Sec. 61.696. REPAYMENT. (a) The board shall deliver any
- 2 repayment under this subchapter in a lump sum payable:
- 3 (1) to both the lender or other holder of the loan and
- 4 the health care worker; or
- 5 (2) directly to the lender or other holder of the loan
- 6 on the health care worker's behalf.
- 7 (b) A repayment under this subchapter may be applied to any
- 8 amount due in connection with the loan.
- 9 Sec. 61.697. AMOUNT OF REPAYMENT ASSISTANCE. (a) A health
- 10 care worker may receive loan repayment assistance under this
- 11 <u>subchapter</u> for each year the health care worker establishes
- 12 eligibility for the assistance in an amount determined by the
- 13 board.
- (b) The board by rule shall determine the maximum amount of
- 15 loan repayment assistance received by a health care worker under
- 16 this subchapter in any one year.
- 17 (c) The total amount of loan repayment assistance provided
- 18 under this subchapter may not exceed the sum of:
- 19 (1) the total amount of gifts and grants accepted by
- 20 the board for the repayment assistance;
- 21 (2) legislative appropriations for the repayment
- 22 assistance; and
- 23 (3) other funds available to the board for the
- 24 repayment assistance.
- 25 (d) The board may adjust in an equitable manner the
- 26 distribution amounts that health care workers would otherwise
- 27 receive under Subsection (a) for a year as necessary to comply with

- 1 Subsection (c).
- 2 Sec. 61.698. RULES; ADMINISTRATION. (a) The board shall
- 3 adopt rules necessary to administer this subchapter.
- 4 (b) The board shall distribute to each institution of higher
- 5 education or private or independent institution of higher education
- 6 and to any appropriate state agency and professional association
- 7 copies of the rules adopted under this section and other pertinent
- 8 information relating to this subchapter.
- 9 (c) The board shall administer the program under this
- 10 subchapter in a manner that maximizes any matching funds available
- 11 through other sources.
- 12 (d) A reasonable amount, not to exceed three percent, of any
- 13 money appropriated for purposes of this subchapter may be used to
- 14 pay the costs of administering this subchapter.
- Sec. 61.699. SOLICITATION AND ACCEPTANCE OF FUNDS. The
- 16 board may solicit and accept gifts and grants from any public or
- 17 private source for the purposes of this subchapter.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
