- 2 relating to the authority of the Public Utility Commission of Texas
- 3 to ensure the independent organization certified for the ERCOT
- 4 power region has adequate reserve power to prevent blackout

- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 39, Utilities Code, is
- 8 amended by adding Section 39.159 to read as follows:
- 9 Sec. 39.159. ENSURING RESERVE POWER CAPACITY. (a) The
- 10 commission by rule shall develop a process for obtaining emergency
- 11 reserve power generation capacity as appropriate to prevent
- 12 blackout conditions caused by shortages of generated power in the
- 13 ERCOT power region. The rules must provide:
- 14 (1) parameters for estimating the amount of emergency
- 15 reserve power generation capacity necessary to prevent blackout
- 16 conditions; and
- 17 (2) mechanisms for equitably sharing the costs of
- 18 making the reserve capacity available and the costs of generated
- 19 power provided to prevent blackout conditions.
- 20 (b) In accordance with rules adopted under Subsection (a),
- 21 an independent organization certified under Section 39.151 for the
- 22 ERCOT power region shall adopt procedures and enter contracts as
- 23 necessary to ensure the availability of a defined amount of
- 24 emergency reserve power generation capacity the organization may

- 1 call on to prevent blackouts caused by shortages of generated
- 2 power.
- 3 (c) Before the independent organization calls on the
- 4 emergency reserve power generation capacity to prevent blackout
- 5 <u>conditions</u>, the organization shall use all other sources of power
- 6 <u>and demand reduction available in accordance with commission rules</u>
- 7 adopted under this section.
- 8 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 9 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 10 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 11 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 12 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
