- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 352.1033, Tax Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsections (a) and (d) and adding Subsection (c-1) to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 (a) Subject to Subsections [Subsection] (c) and (c-1), the
- 9 revenue from a tax imposed under this chapter by a county that
- 10 borders the Gulf of Mexico and that is authorized to impose the tax
- 11 by Section 352.002(a)(6) may be used only to:
- 12 (1) clean public beaches;
- 13 (2) acquire, furnish, or maintain facilities,
- 14 including parks, that enhance public access to beaches;
- 15 (3) provide and maintain public restrooms on or
- 16 adjacent to beaches or beach access facilities;
- 17 (4) provide and maintain litter containers on or
- 18 adjacent to beaches or beach access facilities;
- 19 (5) create, renovate, promote, and maintain parks
- 20 adjacent to bays, rivers, and other navigable waterways if the
- 21 county does not operate a public beach on the Gulf of Mexico;
- 22 (6) advertise and conduct solicitations and
- 23 promotional programs to attract tourists and convention delegates
- 24 or registrants to the county or its vicinity, any of which may be

- 1 conducted by the county or through contracts with persons or
- 2 organizations selected by the county;
- 3 (7) acquire a site for and construct, improve,
- 4 enlarge, equip, repair, operate, and maintain a visitor information
- 5 center; and
- 6 (8) encourage, promote, and improve historical
- 7 preservation and restoration efforts.
- 8 (c-1) In addition to the uses allowed by Subsection (a), a
- 9 county authorized to impose the tax by Section 352.002(a)(6) that
- 10 borders the United Mexican States may use all or any portion of the
- 11 revenue from the tax to construct, improve, repair, and maintain
- 12 infrastructure related to an international toll bridge, including:
- 13 <u>(1) pedestrian walkways;</u>
- 14 (2) street improvements;
- 15 (3) structural levees; and
- 16 (4) parking facilities underneath a hotel adjacent or
- 17 connected to the bridge.
- 18 (d) The limitation prescribed by Subsection (b) does not
- 19 apply to the use of revenue from a tax imposed under this chapter by
- 20 a county to which Subsection (c) or (c-1) applies.
- 21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 25 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
