Section 262.1095(a), Family Code, is amended to read as follows: 6 7 (a) When the Department of Family and Protective Services or another agency takes possession of a child under this chapter, the 8 9 department: (1) shall provide information as prescribed by this 10 section to each adult the department is able to identify and locate 11 12 who is: 13 (A) related to the child within the fourth 14 [third] degree by consanguinity as determined under Chapter 573, Government Code; 15 (B) an adult relative of the alleged father of 16 the child if the department has a reasonable basis to believe the 17 alleged father is the child's biological father; or 18 (C) identified as a potential relative 19 or designated caregiver, as defined by Section 264.751, on the 20 proposed child placement resources form provided under Section 21 261.307; and 22 23 (2) may provide information as prescribed by this 24 section to each adult the department is able to identify and locate

Section 262.114, Family Code, is amended by 3 4 adding Subsection (d) to read as follows: (d) In making a placement decision for a child, the 5 6 department shall give preference to persons in the following order: 7 (1) a person related to the child by blood, marriage, 8 or adoption; 9 (2) a person with whom the child has a long-standing and significant relationship; 10 11 (3) a foster home; and 12 (4) a general residential operation. SECTION 3. Section 264.752, Family Code, is amended by 13 adding Subsection (b) to read as follows: 14 15 (b) The department may not place a child with a relative or 16 other designated caregiver under the program, unless the child's 17 parent or other person having legal custody of the child consents to the placement. The parent or other person having legal custody of 18 19 the child may withdraw consent at any time. 20 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
