- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 39, Utilities Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 39.9165 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 39.9165. SOLAR ENERGY DEVICE OWNER RIGHTS. (a) In
- 8 this section, "solar energy device" has the meaning assigned by
- 9 Section 185.001.

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- 10 (b) A transmission and distribution utility or electric
- 11 utility must allow the owner of a solar energy device that is
- 12 interconnected to the utility's electricity distribution system,
- 13 at the discretion of the owner, to:
- 14 (1) decline to sell electricity produced by the solar
- 15 energy device to the distribution system; or
- 16 (2) temporarily disconnect from the utility's
- 17 electricity distribution system to use on site the electricity
- 18 produced by the solar energy device during a power outage or
- 19 <u>interruption</u>.
- SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 21 an original contract entered into on or after the effective date of
- 22 this Act. An original contract entered into before the effective
- 23 date of this Act is governed by the law as it existed immediately
- 24 before the effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in

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- 1 effect for that purpose.
- 2 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
