8	PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY. (a) In this section, "public health
9	emergency" means an immediate threat from a communicable disease as
10	defined by Section 81.003, Health and Safety Code, that:
11	(1) poses a high risk of death or serious long-term
12	disability to a large number of people in the general population;
13	and
14	(2) creates a substantial risk of public exposure
15	because of the disease's high level of contagion or the method by
16	which the disease is transmitted.
17	(b) Notwithstanding any other law and regardless of whether
18	an inmate has completed any classes or programs that the board has
19	previously ordered the inmate to complete before being released on
20	parole, a parole panel shall consider for release and release on
21	parole an inmate who is eligible for release on parole if the inmate
22	is confined in a facility that is directly affected by a public
23	health emergency and:
24	(1) at least 25 percent of the inmates confined in the

1	facility are infected or suspected of being infected with the
2	communicable disease related to the public health emergency; or
3	(2) the inmate has a high risk of developing serious
4	symptoms or complications from the disease as determined by
5	guidelines established by the federal Centers for Disease Control
6	and Prevention.
7	(c) This section expires September 1, 2024.
8	SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies to any
9	inmate who is confined in a facility operated by or under contract
10	with the Texas Department of Criminal Justice on or after the
1 1	offerstive date of this lat recordlage of whether the offered for

11 effective date of this Act, regardless of whether the offense for 12 which the inmate is confined occurred before, on, or after the 13 effective date of this Act.
