- 9 (1) an appointment to the office of a notary public or

- 11 (2) an appointment of a page, secretary, attendant, or
- 12 other employee by the legislature for attendance on any member of
- 13 the legislature who, because of physical infirmities, is required
- 14 to have a personal attendant;
- 15 (3) a confirmation of the appointment of an appointee
- 16 appointed to a first term on a date when no individual related to
- 17 the appointee within a degree described by Section 573.002 was a
- 18 member of or a candidate for the legislature, or confirmation on
- 19 reappointment of the appointee to any subsequent consecutive term;
- 20 (4) an appointment or employment of a bus driver by a
- 21 school district if:
- (A) the district is located wholly in a county
- 23 with a population of less than 35,000; or
- 24 (B) the district is located in more than one

- 1 county and the county in which the largest part of the district is
- 2 located has a population of less than 35,000;
- 3 (5) an appointment or employment of a personal
- 4 attendant by an officer of the state or a political subdivision of
- 5 the state for attendance on the officer who, because of physical
- 6 infirmities, is required to have a personal attendant;
- 7 (6) an appointment or employment of a substitute
- 8 teacher by a school district;
- 9 (7) an appointment or employment of a person by a
- 10 municipality that has a population of less than 200; or
- 11 (8) an appointment of an election clerk under Section
- 12 32.031, Election Code[, who is not related in the first degree by
- 13 consanguinity or affinity to an elected official of the authority
- 14 that appoints the election judges for that election].
- 15 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
