1 county and the county in which the largest part of the district is
2 located has a population of less than 35,000;

3 (5) an appointment or employment of a personal 4 attendant by an officer of the state or a political subdivision of 5 the state for attendance on the officer who, because of physical 6 infirmities, is required to have a personal attendant;

7 (6) an appointment or employment of a substitute8 teacher by a school district;

9 (7) an appointment or employment of a person by a 10 municipality that has a population of less than 200; or

(8) an appointment of an election clerk under Section 32.031, Election Code[, who is not related in the first degree by consanguinity or affinity to an elected official of the authority that appoints the election judges for that election].
