5	SECTION 1. Section 2269.056(b), Government Code, is amended
6	to read as follows:
7	(b) The governmental entity shall base its selection among
8	offerors on applicable criteria listed for the particular method
9	used. The governmental entity shall publish in the request for
10	proposals or qualifications:
11	(1) the criteria that will be used to evaluate the
12	offerors;
13	(2) the applicable weighted value for each criterion;
14	and
15	(3) [for state agencies,] a detailed methodology for
16	scoring each criterion.
17	SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 2269, Government Code, is
18	amended by adding Section 2269.060 to read as follows:
19	Sec. 2269.060. DOCUMENTS RELATED TO EVALUATION AND RANKING.
20	(a) An offeror who submits a bid, proposal, or response to a
21	request for qualifications for a construction contract under this
22	chapter may, after the contract is awarded, make a request in
23	writing to the governmental entity to provide documents related to
24	the evaluation of the offeror's submission.

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1 (b) Not later than the 30th day after the date a request is made under Subsection (a), the governmental entity shall deliver to 2 the offeror the documents relating to the evaluation of the 3 submission including, if applicable, its ranking of the submission. 4 5 SECTION 3. Section 2269.153, Government Code, is amended to read as follows: 6 Sec. 2269.153. PREPARATION OF REQUEST. 7 (a) In this 8 section, "civil works project" has the meaning assigned by Section 2269.351. 9 The governmental entity shall prepare a request for 10 (b) competitive sealed proposals that includes construction documents, 11 selection criteria and the weighted value for each criterion, 12 estimated budget, project scope, estimated project completion 13 14 date, and other information that a contractor may require to 15 respond to the request. (c) Except as provided by Subsection (d), for civil works 16 17 projects, the weighted value assigned to price must be at least 50 percent of the total weighted value of all selection criteria. 18 If the governing body of a governmental entity 19 (d) determines that assigning a lower weighted value to price is in the 20 public interest, the governmental entity may assign to price a 21 weighted value of not less than 36.9 percent of the total weighted 22 23 value of all selection criteria. 24 SECTION 4. Section 2269.155, Government Code, is amended by 25 adding Subsection (d) to read as follows: 26 (d) Not later than the seventh business day after the date 27 the contract is awarded, the governmental entity shall make the

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1 evaluations, including any scores, public and provide them to all
2 offerors.

3 SECTION 5. Section 2269.452(a), Government Code, is amended 4 to read as follows:

5 (a) This chapter may be enforced through an action for 6 declaratory or injunctive relief filed not later than the 15th calendar [10th] day after the date on which the contract is awarded. 7 8 SECTION 6. The change in law made by this Act applies only to a contract for which a governmental entity first advertises or 9 otherwise solicits bids, proposals, offers, or qualifications or 10 makes a similar solicitation on or after the effective date of this 11 Act. A contract for which a governmental entity first advertises or 12 otherwise solicits bids, proposals, offers, or qualifications or 13 makes a similar solicitation before the effective date of this Act 14 15 is governed by the law in effect on the date the advertisement or solicitation is made, and that law is continued in effect for that 16 17 purpose.

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SECTION 7. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
