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A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to civil works projects and other construction projects of 3 governmental entities. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 2269, Government Code, is amended by adding Section 2269.0525 to read as follows: 6 7 Sec. 2269.0525. PREQUALIFICATION PROCESS FOR CIVIL WORKS PROJECTS. (a) In this section, "civil works project" has the 8 9 meaning assigned by Section 2269.351. (b) A governmental entity may implement a prequalification 10 process to eliminate unqualified offerors from and prequalify 11 potential offerors meeting minimum standards for consideration for 12 a civil works project for which a request for bids, proposals, or 13 qualifications is authorized by this chapter. At least once a year, 14 a governmental entity that implements a prequalification process 15 under this section shall advertise or publish notice of the 16 prequalification process along with a request for qualifications in 17 a manner prescribed by law. In addition, the governmental entity 18 19 may directly solicit qualifications from potential offerors 30 days before the project solicitation is issued if the competitive 20 requirements of this chapter and other applicable law are followed. 21 (c) A governmental entity may prequalify potential offerors 22 23 for consideration for civil works projects more than once a year if: 24 (1) the governmental entity annually provides notice

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1 of the prequalification process as required by Subsection (b); and 2 (2) the prequalification process remains open until at least the 14th day preceding the date responses to a project 3 solicitation are due for a civil works project. 4 5 (d) The implementation of a prequalification process under Subsection (b) or (c) does not affect the authority of a 6 7 governmental entity to determine the responsiveness of any 8 subsequent bid or to reject any and all bids. 9 (e) If a governmental entity considers a contract for a 10 civil works project using the competitive bidding method under this chapter, in implementing a prequalification process under 11 12 Subsection (b) or (c), the governmental entity: (1) shall establish minimum qualification 13 14 requirements for potential offerors and a scoring process with a 15 final pass or fail determination to identify qualified potential offerors who may submit competitive bids; and 16 17 (2) may not short-list or rank potential offerors or combine qualification scores with competitive bids in considering 18 19 the award of a contract. SECTION 2. Section 2269.056(b), Government Code, is amended 20 to read as follows: 21 The governmental entity shall base its selection among 22 (b) offerors on applicable criteria listed for the particular method 23 24 used. The governmental entity shall publish in the request for proposals or qualifications: 25 (1) the criteria that will be used to evaluate the 26 27 offerors;

H.B. No. 2581 (2) the applicable weighted value for each criterion; 2 and

3 (3) [for state agencies,] a detailed methodology for 4 scoring each criterion.

5 SECTION 3. Subchapter B, Chapter 2269, Government Code, is 6 amended by adding Section 2269.060 to read as follows:

Sec. 2269.060. DOCUMENTS RELATED TO EVALUATION AND RANKING.
(a) An offeror who submits a bid, proposal, or response to a
request for qualifications for a construction contract under this
chapter may, after the contract is awarded, make a request in
writing to the governmental entity to provide documents related to
the evaluation of the offeror's submission.

13 (b) Not later than the 30th day after the date a request is 14 made under Subsection (a), the governmental entity shall deliver to 15 the offeror the documents relating to the evaluation of the 16 submission including, if applicable, its ranking of the submission.

SECTION 4. Section 2269.103, Government Code, is amended to read as follows:

19 Sec. 2269.103. PREPARATION OF REQUEST. <u>(a)</u> The 20 governmental entity shall prepare a request for competitive bids 21 that includes construction documents, estimated budget, project 22 scope, estimated project completion date, and other information 23 that a contractor may require to submit a bid.

24 (b) For civil works projects, before preparing a request for 25 competitive bids under Subsection (a), a governmental entity may 26 use the prequalification process for civil works projects described 27 by Section 2269.0525.

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1 SECTION 5. Section 2269.153, Government Code, is amended to
2 read as follows:

Sec. 2269.153. PREPARATION 3 OF REQUEST. (a) The governmental entity shall prepare a request for competitive sealed 4 proposals that includes construction documents, selection criteria 5 and the weighted value for each criterion, estimated budget, 6 project scope, estimated project completion date, and other 7 8 information that a contractor may require to respond to the request. 9

10 (b) Except as provided by Subsection (c), for civil works 11 projects, the weighted value assigned to price must be at least 50 12 percent of the total weighted value of all selection criteria.

13 (c) If the governing body of a governmental entity 14 determines that assigning a lower weighted value to price is in the 15 public interest, the governmental entity may assign to price a 16 weighted value of not less than 40 percent of the total weighted 17 value of all selection criteria.

SECTION 6. Section 2269.155, Government Code, is amended by adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:

20 <u>(d) Not later than the seventh business day after the date</u> 21 <u>the contract is awarded, the governmental entity shall make the</u> 22 <u>evaluations, including any scores, public and provide them to all</u> 23 <u>offerors.</u>

24 SECTION 7. Section 2269.452(a), Government Code, is amended 25 to read as follows:

(a) This chapter may be enforced through an action for
 declaratory or injunctive relief filed not later than the <u>15th</u>

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<u>calendar</u> [10th] day after the date on which the contract is awarded. 1 SECTION 8. The change in law made by this Act applies only 2 to a contract for which a governmental entity first advertises or 3 otherwise solicits bids, proposals, offers, or qualifications or 4 makes a similar solicitation on or after the effective date of this 5 6 Act. A contract for which a governmental entity first advertises or otherwise solicits bids, proposals, offers, or qualifications or 7 8 makes a similar solicitation before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the advertisement or 9 solicitation is made, and that law is continued in effect for that 10 11 purpose.

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SECTION 9. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
