- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 791, Government Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 791.038 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 791.038. CONTRACTS FOR THE PROVISION OF LAW
- 9 ENFORCEMENT SERVICES IN CERTAIN MUNICIPALITIES. (a) This section
- 10 applies only to:
- 11 (1) a county with a population of 800,000 or more and
- 12 located on the international border; and
- 13 (2) a municipality located wholly in a county
- 14 described by Subdivision (1).
- 15 (b) A municipality that enters into an interlocal contract
- 16 with a county under this chapter for the county to provide law
- 17 enforcement services to the municipality may abolish its municipal
- 18 police department.
- 19 (c) A county that enters into an interlocal contract with a
- 20 municipality under this chapter for the county to provide law
- 21 enforcement services to the municipality must assign county law
- 22 enforcement officers to discharge official duties in the
- 23 municipality.
- SECTION 2. Section 791.038, Government Code, as added by

H.B. No. 2592

- 1 this Act, applies only to a contract entered into on or after the
- 2 effective date of this Act.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
