4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 48, Penal Code, is amended by adding
6	Section 48.05 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 48.05. PROHIBITED CAMPING. (a) In this section:
8	(1) "Camp" means to reside temporarily in a place,
9	with shelter.
10	(2) "Controlled access highway" has the meaning
11	assigned by Section 203.001, Transportation Code.
12	(3) "Shelter" includes a tent, a tarpaulin, a lean-to,
13	a sleeping bag, a bedroll, blankets, or any form of shelter, other
14	than clothing, designed to protect a person from weather conditions
15	that threaten personal health and safety.
16	(b) A person commits an offense if the person intentionally
17	or knowingly camps under:
18	(1) a controlled access highway; or
19	(2) the frontage road of a controlled access highway.
20	(c) An offense under this section is a Class C misdemeanor.
21	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
