7	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 552, Government Code, is
8	amended by adding Section 552.1082 to read as follows:
9	Sec. 552.1082. EXCEPTION: CERTAIN PERSONAL INFORMATION
10	FROM TRAFFIC VIOLATION RECORDS. (a) Except as provided by
11	Subsection (b), information contained in a citation issued for a
12	violation of a state traffic law or local traffic ordinance is
13	excepted from the requirements of Section 552.021 if the
14	information is the home address or personal telephone number of the
15	person who is the subject of a citation.
16	(b) Information described by Subsection (a) shall be made
17	available on the request of:
18	(1) a radio or television station that holds a license
19	issued by the Federal Communications Commission; or
20	(2) a newspaper that is:
21	(A) a free newspaper of general circulation or
22	qualified under Section 2051.044 to publish legal notices;
23	(B) published at least once a week; and
24	(C) available and of interest to the general

- 2 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
