A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to a Department of Public Safety database concerning peace
- 3 officer misconduct.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 2, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
- 6 amended by adding Article 2.1397 to read as follows:
- 7 Art. 2.1397. DUTIES OF LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY REGARDING
- 8 PEACE OFFICER MISCONDUCT. (a) In this article, "law enforcement
- 9 agency" means an agency of the state or an agency of a political
- 10 <u>subdivision</u> of the state authorized by law to employ peace
- 11 officers.
- 12 (b) A law enforcement agency shall promptly report to the
- 13 Department of Public Safety for inclusion in the database
- 14 established under Section 411.056, Government Code, each
- 15 allegation of misconduct concerning a peace officer employed by the
- 16 agency. The report must be made on the form adopted by that
- 17 department and must include information regarding:
- 18 <u>(1) the nature of the allegation;</u>
- 19 (2) the results of the agency's investigation of the
- 20 allegation; and
- 21 (3) any disciplinary action taken by the agency as a
- 22 result of the allegation.
- 23 SECTION 2. Subchapter D, Chapter 411, Government Code, is
- 24 amended by adding Section 411.056 to read as follows:

- Sec. 411.056. DATABASE OF PEACE OFFICER MISCONDUCT; REPORT.
- 2 (a) The department shall:
- 3 (1) adopt a form for the reporting of misconduct
- 4 allegations under Article 2.1397, Code of Criminal Procedure;
- 5 (2) establish a database for information concerning
- 6 reports received under that article; and
- 7 (3) make the database accessible to law enforcement
- 8 agencies in this state.
- 9 (b) Not later than June 1 and December 1 of each year, the
- 10 department shall submit a report regarding peace officer misconduct
- 11 to the governor, lieutenant governor, and each standing committee
- 12 of the legislature with primary jurisdiction over criminal justice
- 13 matters. The report must include information regarding the type
- 14 and frequency of misconduct allegations in this state.
- 15 <u>(c) The department shall make each report submitted under</u>
- 16 Subsection (b) available on the department's Internet website.
- 17 SECTION 3. Not later than January 1, 2022, the Department of
- 18 Public Safety of the State of Texas shall adopt the form and
- 19 establish the database as required by Section 411.056, Government
- 20 Code, as added by this Act.
- 21 SECTION 4. The Department of Public Safety of the State of
- 22 Texas shall submit its first report under Section 411.056(b),
- 23 Government Code, as added by this Act, not later than June 1, 2022.
- SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
