A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to rolling blackouts. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 38, Utilities Code, is 5 amended by adding Section 38.074 to read as follows: 6 Sec. 38.074. ROLLING BLACKOUTS. The commission by rule shall require each electric utility, municipally owned utility, and 7 electric cooperative that is subject to a rolling blackout 8 9 initiated by an independent organization certified under Section 39.151 to rotate customer curtailment so that no customer is 10 11 subject to an outage of more than 12 hours. 12 SECTION 2. (a) The Public Utility Commission of Texas shall 13 conduct a study on: 14 (1) methods to make the imposition of a rolling 15 blackout equitable across the state; and (2) measures needed in this state to prevent the 16 necessity of rolling blackouts. 17 (b) Not later than September 1, 2022, the Public Utility 18 Commission of Texas shall submit to the legislature a report on the 19 20 results of the study. 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.

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
