A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the authority of an independent school district to change the date of the general election and terms for officers. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 11.059, Education Code, is amended by 5 adding Subsection (e) to read as follows: 6 (e) Not later than December 31, 2026, the board of trustees 7 may adopt a resolution changing the length of the terms of its 8 9 trustees. The resolution must provide for staggered terms of either three or four years and specify the manner in which the transition 10 from the length of the former term to the modified term is made. The 11 transition must begin with the first regular election for trustees 12 that occurs after the board adopts the resolution, and a trustee who 13 14 serves on the date the resolution is adopted shall serve the remainder of that term. This subsection expires January 1, 2032. 15 16 SECTION 2. Section 41.0052, Election Code, is amended by adding Subsection (a-2) to read as follows: 17 18 (a-2) The governing body of an independent school district that holds its general election for officers on a date other than 19 the November uniform election date may, not later than December 31, 20 2026, change the date on which it holds its general election for 21 officers to the November uniform election date. This subsection 22 expires January 1, 2027. 23 24 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
