3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 28.002(z), Education Code, is amended to
5	read as follows:
6	(z) The State Board of Education by rule shall require each
7	school district to incorporate instruction in digital citizenship
8	into the district's curriculum, including information regarding
9	the potential criminal consequences of cyberbullying, and require
10	students enrolled in grade level six to complete instruction in
11	digital citizenship as part of the district's social studies
12	curriculum. In this subsection:
13	(1) "Cyberbullying" has the meaning assigned by
14	Section 37.0832.
15	(2) "Digital citizenship" means the standards of
16	appropriate, responsible, and healthy online behavior, including <u>:</u>
17	(A) media literacy and the ability to identify
18	credible sources of information and access, analyze, evaluate,
19	create, and act on all forms of digital communication <u>;</u>
20	(B) digital ethics, etiquette, safety, security,
21	and the identification of hate speech, racism, and discrimination;
22	and
23	(C) cyberbullying prevention and response.
24	SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2021-2022

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1 school year.

2 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
