- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 39, Utilities Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 39.159 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 39.159. REQUIRED INTERCONNECTION WITH TRANSMISSION
- 8 FACILITIES OUTSIDE OF ERCOT. (a) The commission shall identify
- 9 transmission facilities in ERCOT that may be interconnected with
- 10 transmission facilities outside of ERCOT for the purpose of
- 11 allowing federal regulation of transmission service and wholesale
- 12 power sales in ERCOT.
- 13 (b) Notwithstanding any other law, the commission shall
- 14 require an electric utility, municipally owned utility, or electric
- 15 cooperative that owns a transmission facility identified by the
- 16 commission under Subsection (a) to make requests, obtain approvals,
- 17 enter into contracts, and construct facilities as necessary to
- 18 interconnect the facility with a transmission facility outside of
- 19 <u>ERCOT.</u>
- SECTION 2. Not later than November 1, 2022, the Public
- 21 Utility Commission of Texas shall examine the laws and rules
- 22 governing electric utilities in this state to determine how Section
- 23 39.159, Utilities Code, as added by this Act, may affect the
- 24 application of those laws and rules and shall adopt recommendations

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- 1 for legislative and administrative action as necessary to implement
- 2 that section as effectively as practicable.
- 3 SECTION 3. (a) Section 39.159, Utilities Code, as added by
- 4 this Act, takes effect September 1, 2023.
- 5 (b) Section 2 of this Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
