A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT 2 relating to the authority of certain municipalities to receive certain tax revenue derived from a hotel and convention center 3 project and related establishments and to pledge certain tax 5 revenue for the payment of obligations related to the project. 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. - 23 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 25 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 26 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 27 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
