H.B. No. 2699

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the acceptance of a provisional ballot after a natural 3 disaster. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Section 65.054(b), Election Code, is amended to read as follows: 6 7 (b) A provisional ballot shall be accepted if the board determines that: 8 (1) from the information in the affidavit or contained 9 in public records, the person is eligible to vote in the election 10 and has not previously voted in that election; 11 12 (2) the person: 13 (A) meets the identification requirements of Section 63.001(b) at the time the ballot was cast or in the period 14 prescribed under Section 65.0541; 15 (B) notwithstanding Chapter 110, Civil Practice 16 and Remedies Code, executes an affidavit under penalty of perjury 17 18 that states the voter has a religious objection to being photographed and the voter has consistently refused to be 19 photographed for any governmental purpose from the time the voter 20 21 has held this belief; or (C) executes 22 an affidavit under penalty of 23 perjury that states the voter does not have any identification meeting the requirements of Section 63.001(b) as a result of a 24

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1 natural disaster that was declared by the president of the United States or the governor, occurred not earlier than the 60th day [45 2 days] before the date the ballot was cast, and caused the 3 4 destruction of or inability to access the voter's identification; 5 and

6 (3) the voter has not been challenged and voted a 7 provisional ballot solely because the voter did not meet the 8 requirements for identification prescribed by Section 63.001(b). 9

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
