- 14 (b) When a boil water notice is no longer in effect, the

  16 customer that the boil water notice has expired in the manner

- SECTION 2. Subchapter A, Chapter 186, Utilities Code, is amended by adding Section 186.008 to read as follows:
- Sec. 186.008. WEATHERIZATION. The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality may require that a public utility that furnishes water to the public complete a program of weatherization if that commission finds that the public utility is at risk of being unable to provide water to customers for a significant period of

- 1 time due to weather-related failures in equipment or
- 2 <u>infrastructure.</u>
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
