H.B. No. 2741

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT
2 relating to eligibility for a service retirement annuity of members
3 of the elected class of the Employees Retirement System of Texas.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 814.102, Government Code, is amended to
6 read as follows:

7 Sec. 814.102. ELIGIBILITY OF ELECTED MEMBERS FOR SERVICE
8 RETIREMENT. Except as provided by rule adopted under Section
9 813.304(d) or Section 803.202(a)(2), a member who has service
10 credit in the elected class of membership, is eligible to retire and
11 receive a service retirement annuity if the member:

12 (1) is at least 60 years old and has:

13 (A) except as provided by Paragraph (B) of this
14 subdivision, eight [8] years of service credit in that class; or

15 (B) six years of service credit in that class, if
16 the member:

17 (i) has at least two years of military
18 service; and

19 (ii) if applicable, was released from
20 military duty under conditions not dishonorable; or

21 (2) is at least 50 years old and has:

22 (A) except as provided by Paragraph (B) of this
23 subdivision, 12 years of service credit in that class; or

24 (B) 10 years of service credit in that class, if

1 the member:

2 (i) has at least two years of military
3 service; and

4 (ii) if applicable, was released from
5 military duty under conditions not dishonorable.

6 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
