- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 42.13, Penal Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsection (c) and adding Subsections (d) and (e) to read
- 7 as follows:
- 8 (c) An offense under this section is a Class C misdemeanor,
- 9 except that the offense is a felony of the third degree if the
- 10 conduct causes serious bodily injury to the officer.
- 11 (d) It is a defense to prosecution under this section that
- 12 at the time of the offense the actor was discharging the actor's
- 13 duties as a lighting technician at a venue which produces or hosts
- 14 events involving laser pointers, including a concert or similar
- 15 event.
- 16 (e) If conduct that constitutes an offense under this
- 17 section also constitutes an offense under any other law, the actor
- 18 may be prosecuted under this section, the other law, or both.
- 19 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 20 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 21 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 22 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,
- 23 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 24 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the

- 1 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense was
- 2 committed before that date.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
