16	(4) [(3)] a county with a population of 400,000 or

19	(5) a county with a population of less than 250,000

21	(A) is adjacent to two counties that each have a

(B) contains two highways that are part of the

population of more than 1.2 million; and

national system of interstate and defense highways.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

5 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
