8	not require a health benefit plan to provide coverage for dental
9	care or procedures.
10	SECTION 2. Subchapter G, Chapter 1367, Insurance Code, as
11	added by this Act, applies only to a health benefit plan that is
12	delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed on or after January 1,
13	2022.
14	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
