4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 1367, Insurance Code, is amended by
6	adding Subchapter G to read as follows:
7	SUBCHAPTER G. PEDIATRIC DENTISTRY
8	Sec. 1367.301. APPLICABILITY OF SUBCHAPTER. (a) This
9	subchapter applies only to a health benefit plan that provides
10	benefits for medical or surgical expenses incurred as a result of a
11	health condition, accident, or sickness, including an individual,
12	group, blanket, or franchise insurance policy or insurance
13	agreement, a group hospital service contract, or an individual or
14	group evidence of coverage or similar coverage document that is
15	offered by:
16	(1) an insurance company;
17	(2) a group hospital service corporation operating
18	under Chapter 842;
19	(3) a health maintenance organization operating under
20	Chapter 843;
21	(4) an approved nonprofit health corporation that
22	holds a certificate of authority under Chapter 844;
23	(5) a multiple employer welfare arrangement that holds
24	a certificate of authority under Chapter 846;

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1	(6) a stipulated premium insurance company operating
2	under Chapter 884;
3	(7) a fraternal benefit society operating under
4	Chapter 885;
5	(8) a Lloyd's plan operating under Chapter 941; or
6	(9) an exchange operating under Chapter 942.
7	(b) Notwithstanding any other law, this subchapter applies
8	<u>to:</u>
9	(1) a small employer health benefit plan subject to
10	Chapter 1501, including coverage provided through a health group
11	cooperative under Subchapter B of that chapter;
12	(2) a standard health benefit plan issued under
13	Chapter 1507;
14	(3) a basic coverage plan under Chapter 1551;
15	(4) a basic plan under Chapter 1575;
16	(5) a primary care coverage plan under Chapter 1579;
17	(6) a plan providing basic coverage under Chapter
18	<u>1601;</u>
19	(7) health benefits provided by or through a church
20	benefits board under Subchapter I, Chapter 22, Business
21	Organizations Code;
22	(8) a regional or local health care program operated
23	under Section 75.104, Health and Safety Code; and
24	(9) a self-funded health benefit plan sponsored by a
25	professional employer organization under Chapter 91, Labor Code.
26	(c) This subchapter applies to coverage under a group health
27	benefit plan described by Subsection (a) provided to a resident of

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1	this state, regardless of whether the group policy, agreement, or
2	contract is delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed in this
3	state.
4	Sec. 1367.302. COVERAGE FOR GENERAL ANESTHESIA. A health
5	benefit plan that provides coverage for general anesthesia may not
6	exclude from coverage general anesthesia services in connection
7	with dental services provided to a covered individual who is:
8	(1) younger than 18 years of age; and
9	(2) unable to undergo the dental service in an office
10	setting due to a documented physical, mental, or medical reason
11	determined by the individual's physician or by the dentist
12	providing the dental care.
13	Sec. 1367.303. COVERAGE NOT REQUIRED. This subchapter does
14	not require a health benefit plan to provide coverage for dental
15	care or procedures.
16	SECTION 2. Subchapter G, Chapter 1367, Insurance Code, as
17	added by this Act, applies only to a health benefit plan that is
18	delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed on or after January 1,
19	2022.
20	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
