6	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 4102, Insurance Code, is
7	amended by adding Section 4102.0021 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 4102.0021. EXEMPTIONS FOR CERTAIN CONTRACTOR SERVICES
9	OR COMMUNICATIONS. This chapter does not apply to the following
10	actions by a contractor who has been engaged by an insured to
11	<pre>complete work covered under a property insurance policy:</pre>
12	(1) providing supplement estimates to the insurer;
13	(2) submitting photographs, code documentation,
14	manufacturer specifications, or any other supporting documents to
15	the insurer;
16	(3) suggesting the insured invoke the appraisal clause
17	in the insured's policy or suggesting the insured hire a public
18	insurance adjuster or attorney in connection with the insured's
19	<pre>claim; or</pre>
20	(4) engaging in conversations with an insurer, or
21	their agent, to clarify the scope of work provided in the written

<u>estimate.</u>

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a contract entered into on or after the effective date of this Act.

SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to

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- 1 A contract entered into before the effective date of this Act is
- 2 governed by the law in effect immediately before the effective date
- 3 of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
