- 5 SECTION 1. Section 6.412(d), Tax Code, is amended to read as

- 7 (d) A person is ineligible to serve on the appraisal review
- 8 board of an appraisal district established for a county described
- 9 by Section 6.41(d-1) if the person:
- 10 (1) is a former member of the board of directors,
- 11 former officer, or former employee of the appraisal district;
- 12 (2) served as a member of the governing body or officer
- 13 of a taxing unit for which the appraisal district appraises
- 14 property, until the fourth anniversary of the date the person
- 15 ceased to be a member or officer;
- 16 (3) appeared before the appraisal review board for
- 17 compensation during the two-year period preceding the date the
- 18 person is appointed; or
- 19 (4) served for all or part of:

- 21 auxiliary board member on the appraisal review board; or
- (B) one previous term as a board member or

1 <u>one million or more</u>.

- 2 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act does not
- 3 affect the eligibility of a person serving on an appraisal review
- 4 board immediately before the effective date of this Act to continue
- 5 to serve on the board for the term to which the member was
- 6 appointed.
- 7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect January 1, 2022.
