4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Chapter 38, Code of Criminal Procedure, is

- amended by adding Article 38.372 to read as follows:

 Art. 38.372. EVIDENCE IN PROSECUTION OF TRAFFICKING OR

 PROSTITUTION-RELATED OFFENSE. (a) This article applies to a

 proceeding in the prosecution of a defendant for an offense, or for

 an attempt or conspiracy to commit an offense, under any of the

 following provisions of the Penal Code:

 (1) Chapter 20A (Trafficking of Persons);
- 13 (2) Section 43.03 (Promotion of Prostitution);
- 14 (3) Section 43.031 (Online Promotion of
- 15 Prostitution);
- 16 (4) Section 43.04 (Aggravated Promotion of
- 17 <u>Prostitution</u>);
- 18 (5) Section 43.041 (Aggravated Online Promotion of
- 19 Prostitution); or
- 20 (6) Section 43.05 (Compelling Prostitution).
- 21 (b) In the prosecution of an offense described by Subsection
- 22 (a), subject to the Texas Rules of Evidence or other applicable law,
- 23 the state may offer testimony or other evidence of all relevant
- 24 facts and circumstances that would assist the trier of fact in

- 1 determining whether the actor committed the offense described by
- 2 Subsection (a), including testimony or evidence regarding the
- 3 nature of the relationship between the actor and the alleged
- 4 victim.
- 5 (c) This article does not permit the presentation of
- 6 character evidence that would otherwise be inadmissible under the
- 7 Texas Rules of Evidence or other applicable law, including:
- 8 (1) reputation or opinion evidence of a victim's past
- 9 sexual behavior; or
- 10 (2) evidence of specific instances of a victim's past
- 11 sexual behavior.
- 12 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 13 to a criminal proceeding that commences on or after the effective
- 14 date of this Act. A criminal proceeding that commences before the
- 15 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect when the
- 16 proceeding commenced, and the former law is continued in effect for
- 17 that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
