- 4 SECTION 1. Section 572.057, Local Government Code, is
- 5 amended by amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsections (b-1) and
- 6 (c-1) to read as follows:
- 7 (b) Except as provided by Subsection (b-1), each [Each]
- 8 director must be appointed by place by the governing bodies of the
- 9 participating public entities. Each participating public entity is
- 10 entitled to appoint at least one director.
- 11 (b-1) If a public utility agency has a service area that
- 12 includes the unincorporated area of a county that is outside the
- 13 boundaries of the agency's participating public entities, the
- 14 commissioners court of the county may appoint the same number of
- 15 directors as the number appointed by the participating public
- 16 entity with the largest population that is less than the population
- 17 of the unincorporated area.
- 18 <u>(c-1)</u> A director must be a customer of the public utility
- 19 agency and reside within the area served by the agency.
- SECTION 2. Section 572.057(c-1), Local Government Code, as
- 21 added by this Act, applies only to the term of a director that
- 22 begins on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
