BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 225, Transportation Code, is amended by adding Section 225.190 to read as follows: Sec. 225.190. DEPUTY KENNETH MALTBY MEMORIAL HIGHWAY.
