A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to eligibility for the Texas Armed Services Scholarship 3 Program. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Section 61.9773(a), Education Code, is amended to read as follows: 6 (a) To receive a scholarship under this subchapter, a 7 student must enter into an agreement with the board as provided by 8 9 this section. The agreement must require the student to: 10 (1) complete: 11 (A) one year of ROTC training for each year that 12 the student receives the scholarship, up to a maximum requirement of four years of ROTC training; or 13 14 (B) [complete] another undergraduate officer commissioning program such as the United States Marine Corps 15 Platoon Leaders Class; 16 (2) graduate not later than six years after the date 17 the student first enrolls in a public or private institution of 18 higher education in this state; 19 (3) after graduation, enter into: 20 21 (A) a four-year commitment to be a member of the Texas Army National Guard, Texas Air National Guard, Texas State 22 Guard, United States Coast Guard, or United States Merchant Marine; 23 24 or

No. 2815 1 (B) a contract to serve as a commissioned officer in any branch of the armed services of the United States; 2 3 (4) meet the physical examination requirements and all other prescreening requirements of the Texas Army National Guard, 4 5 Texas Air National Guard, Texas State Guard, United States Coast Guard, or United States Merchant Marine or the branch of the armed 6 services with which the student enters into a contract; and 7 8 (5) agree to repay the scholarship if the student: 9 (A) fails to maintain satisfactory academic 10 progress; withdraws from the scholarship program; or 11 (B) fails to fulfill a commitment or contract 12 (C) described by Subdivision (3). 13 SECTION 2. Section 61.9773(a), Education Code, as amended 14 15 by this Act, applies beginning with a Texas Armed Services Scholarship awarded for the 2021-2022 academic year. A Texas Armed 16 17 Services Scholarship awarded for an academic year before that academic year is governed by the law in effect when the scholarship 18 was awarded, and the former law is continued in effect for that 19 20 purpose. 21 SECTION 3. The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board shall adopt rules for the administration of Section 61.9773(a), 22 23 Education Code, as amended by this Act, as soon as practicable after 24 this Act takes effect. 25 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

26 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 27 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

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Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
Act takes effect September 1, 2021.

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
