- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 4001.153, Insurance Code, is amended to
- 5 read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 4001.153. APPLICATION FOR AND ISSUANCE OF TEMPORARY
- 7 LICENSE. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b), the [The]
- 8 department shall issue a temporary license immediately on receipt
- 9 of a properly completed application executed by the applicant in
- 10 the form required by Section 4001.102 and accompanied by:
- 11 (1) the nonrefundable filing fee set by the
- 12 department; and
- 13 (2) a certificate signed by an officer or properly
- 14 authorized representative of an agent, insurer, or health
- 15 maintenance organization stating that:
- 16 (A) the applicant is being considered for
- 17 appointment by the agent, insurer, or health maintenance
- 18 organization as its full-time agent;
- 19 (B) the agent, insurer, or health maintenance
- 20 organization desires that the applicant be issued a temporary
- 21 license; and
- (C) the applicant will complete training as
- 23 prescribed by Section 4001.160 under the agent's, insurer's, or
- 24 health maintenance organization's supervision.

- 1 (b) The department may deny a license application under this
- 2 subchapter if the department determines that any of the grounds
- 3 exist for license denial or disciplinary action under Section
- 4 4005.101, Insurance Code, or Chapter 53, Occupations Code.
- 5 SECTION 2. Section 4001.155, Insurance Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 4001.155. TERM OF TEMPORARY LICENSE. A temporary
- 8 license is valid for 180 [90] days after the date of issuance.
- 9 SECTION 3. Section 4001.156(a), Insurance Code, is
- 10 repealed.
- 11 SECTION 4. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 12 an application for a temporary insurance agent's license submitted
- 13 on or after the effective date of this Act. An application for a
- 14 temporary insurance agent's license submitted before the effective
- 15 date of this Act is governed by the law as it existed immediately
- 16 before that date, and that law is continued in effect for that
- 17 purpose.
- SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
