| 5 | SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 38, Utilities Code, is |
| 6 | amended by adding Section 38.074 to read as follows: |
| 7 | Sec. 38.074. ROLLING BLACKOUTS. (a) Except as provided by |
| 8 | Subsection (b), the commission by rule shall require each electric |
| 9 | utility, municipally owned utility, and electric cooperative that |
| 10 | is subject to a rolling blackout initiated by an independent |
| 11 | organization certified under Section 39.151 to rotate customer |
| 12 | curtailment so that no customer is subject to an outage of more than |
| 13 | 12 hours. |
| 14 | (b) The commission may make exceptions to a requirement |
| 15 | adopted under Subsection (a) to allow an electric utility, |
| 16 | municipally owned utility, or electric cooperative to maintain a |
| 17 | customer outage for more than 12 hours to the extent necessary to |
| 18 | supply facilities the commission determines are critical to |
| 19 | maintaining public health and safety. |
| 20 | SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021. |

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
