A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT 2 relating to provider discrimination against a Medicaid recipient or child health plan program enrollee based on immunization status. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 531, Government Code, is amended by adding Section 531.02119 to read as follows: 6 7 Sec. 531.02119. DISCRIMINATION BASED ON IMMUNIZATION STATUS PROHIBITED. (a) A provider who participates in Medicaid or 8 9 the child health plan program, including a provider participating in the provider network of a managed care organization that 10 contracts with the commission to provide services under Medicaid or 11 the child health plan program, may not refuse to provide health care 12 services to a Medicaid recipient or child health plan program 13 14 enrollee based on the recipient's or enrollee's refusal or failure to obtain a vaccine or immunization for a particular infectious or 15 16 communicable disease. (b) The commission may not provide reimbursement and shall 17 disenroll from participation as a provider under Medicaid or the 18 child health plan program a provider who violates this section. 19 (c) The executive commissioner may adopt rules as necessary 20 21 to implement this section. SECTION 2. If before implementing any provision of this Act 22

23 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a 24 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,

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1 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or 2 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the 3 waiver or authorization is granted.

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4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
