5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Section 4.003(e), Election Code, is amended to
7	read as follows:
8	(e) The authority responsible for giving notice of the
9	election shall deliver to the secretary of state $\underline{:}$
10	(1) a copy of the notice of a consolidated precinct
11	required by Subsection (b) not later than the date of the election;
12	and
13	(2) information for the secretary of state's database
14	of election information under Section 31.017 in an electronic
15	format required by the secretary of state.
16	SECTION 2. Subchapter A, Chapter 31, Election Code, is
17	amended by adding Sections 31.017 and 31.018 to read as follows:
18	Sec. 31.017. INTERNET DATABASE OF ELECTION INFORMATION.
19	(a) The secretary of state shall post on the secretary of state's
20	public Internet website a database containing information provided
21	by each authority responsible for giving notice of an election in
22	this state. The database must include the following information:
23	(1) the name of the authority;

(2) each office to be filled at the election;

1	(3) whether the office is elected at large or by
2	district; and
3	(4) the dates of the preceding and next election for
4	the office.
5	(b) The secretary of state:
6	(1) may solicit and accept gifts, grants, and
7	donations from any public or private source for the creation and
8	<pre>maintenance of the database; and</pre>
9	(2) shall adopt rules as necessary to implement this
10	section.
11	Sec. 31.018. INTERNET DATABASE FOR INCUMBENTS AND
12	CANDIDATES. (a) The secretary of state shall post on the secretary
13	of state's Internet website a database containing information about
14	each holder of and candidate for any elected office in this state.
15	(b) The database must include the following information
16	about a holder of an elected office:
17	(1) name;
18	(2) office title, including any district, place, or
19	<pre>position;</pre>
20	(3) if the office is elected at large or by district;
21	(4) date of the previous and next election for the
22	<pre>office;</pre>
23	(5) public mailing address;
24	(6) public telephone number, if available; and
25	(7) public e-mail address, if available.
26	(c) The database must include the following information
27	about a candidate for an elected office:

- (1) name; 1 2 (2) office sought, including any district, place, or 3 position; 4 (3) if the office is elected at large or by district; 5 (4) date of the election; (5) public mailing address; 6 7 (6) public telephone number, if available; 8 (7) public e-mail address, if available; 9 (8) name of the incumbent; and 10 (9) if the candidate has filed as a write-in candidate. 11 (d) The authority with whom a declaration of candidacy is 12 filed, a state chair of a political party, or the presiding officer 13 14 of a political party's convention shall provide information about a 15 candidate or officeholder to the secretary of state. 16 (e) The secretary of state may prescribe any procedures 17 necessary to implement this section. SECTION 3. Section 52.003, Election Code, is amended by 18 adding Subsection (d) to read as follows: 19
- (d) A candidate's name may not be printed on the ballot 20
- until the candidate's name appears on the secretary of state's 21
- Internet website as a candidate for elected office under Section 22
- 23 31.018.
- SECTION 4. Section 141.032, Election Code, is amended by 24
- adding Subsection (h) to read as follows: 25
- (h) The authority with whom the application is filed shall 26
- provide the secretary of state with the candidate's information 27

- 3 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
