6	SECTION 1. Subchapter ${\tt Z}$, Chapter ${\tt 25}$, Education Code, is
7	amended by adding Section 25.902 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 25.902. STUDENT IDENTIFICATION CARDS. A school
9	district or open-enrollment charter school shall issue to each high
10	school student enrolled in the district or school a student
11	identification card that includes the student's:
12	<u>(1) name;</u>
13	(2) photograph; and
14	(3) date of birth.
15	SECTION 2. Section 63.0101(a), Election Code, is amended to
16	read as follows:
17	(a) The following documentation is an acceptable form of
18	photo identification under this chapter:

- 19 (1) a driver's license, election identification
- certificate, or personal identification card issued to the person 20
- 21 by the Department of Public Safety that has not expired or that
- expired no earlier than four years before the date of presentation; 22
- 23 (2) a United States military identification card that 24

- 1 expired no earlier than four years before the date of presentation;
- 2 (3) a United States citizenship certificate issued to
- 3 the person that contains the person's photograph;
- 4 (4) a United States passport book or card issued to the
- 5 person that has not expired or that expired no earlier than four
- 6 years before the date of presentation; [or]
- 7 (5) a license to carry a handgun issued to the person
- 8 by the Department of Public Safety that has not expired or that
- 9 expired no earlier than four years before the date of presentation;
- 10 (6) a student identification card issued to the person
- 11 by a public or private high school that contains the person's
- 12 photograph and date of birth; or
- 13 (7) a student identification card issued to the person
- 14 by an institution of higher education that contains the person's
- 15 photograph and date of birth; or
- 16 (8) any other identification card, form, or
- 17 certificate containing the person's photograph and date of birth
- 18 issued by this state, an agency or political subdivision of this
- 19 state, or the United States.
- SECTION 3. Section 25.902, Education Code, as added by this
- 21 Act, applies beginning with the 2021-2022 school year.
- 22 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 25 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 26 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
