## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to notice required in connection with possessory liens on

- 3 certain motor vehicles.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 70.006, Property Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsections (a) and (b-1) and adding Subsection (a-1) to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 (a) A holder of a lien under this subchapter on a motor
- 9 vehicle subject to Chapter 501, Transportation Code, or on a
- 10 motorboat, vessel, or outboard motor for which a certificate of
- 11 title is required under Subchapter B, Chapter 31, Parks and
- 12 Wildlife Code, as amended, who retains possession of the motor
- 13 vehicle, motorboat, vessel, or outboard motor shall give written
- 14 notice to the owner and each holder of a lien recorded on the
- 15 certificate of title. Subject to Subsection (a-1) [Not later than
- 16 the 30th day after the date on which the charges accrue], a holder
- 17 of a possessory lien on a motor vehicle under Section 70.001, other
- 18 than a person licensed as a franchised dealer under Chapter 2301,
- 19 Occupations Code, shall file a copy of the notice and all
- 20 information required by this section with the county tax
- 21 assessor-collector's office in the county in which the repairs were
- 22 made with an administrative fee of \$25 payable to the county tax
- 23 assessor-collector. If the motor vehicle, motorboat, vessel, or
- 24 outboard motor is registered outside this state, the holder of a

- 1 lien under this subchapter who retains possession during that
- 2 period shall give notice to the last known registered owner and each
- 3 lienholder of record.
- 4 (a-1) A copy of the notice and information required to be
- 5 filed with the county tax assessor-collector's office under
- 6 Subsection (a) must be filed:
- 7 (1) for a motor vehicle that has a gross vehicle weight
- 8 rating of less than 16,000 pounds, not later than the 30th day after
- 9 the date on which the charges accrue; and
- 10 (2) for a motor vehicle that has a gross vehicle weight
- 11 rating equal to or greater than 16,000 pounds, not later than the
- 12 later of the 30th day after the date on which the charges accrue or
- 13 the 30th day before the date of a proposed sale or disposition of
- 14 the motor vehicle under Subsection (f) or (f-1).
- 15 (b-1) A holder of a possessory lien on a motor vehicle under
- 16 Section 70.001, other than a person licensed as a franchised dealer
- 17 under Chapter 2301, Occupations Code, who is required to give
- 18 notice to a lienholder of record under this section must include in
- 19 the notice:
- 20 (1) the physical address of the real property at which
- 21 the repairs to the motor vehicle were made;
- 22 (2) the legal name of the person that holds the
- 23 possessory lien for which the notice is required;
- 24 (3) the taxpayer identification number or employer
- 25 identification number, as applicable, of the person that holds the
- 26 possessory lien for which the notice is required; [and]
- 27 (4) a signed copy of the work order authorizing the

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- 1 repairs on the motor vehicle; and
- 2 (5) if applicable, the proposed date of the sale or
- 3 disposition of the motor vehicle under Subsection (f) or (f-1).
- 4 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 5 a possessory lien on a motor vehicle the possession of which is
- 6 obtained on or after the effective date of this Act. A possessory
- 7 lien on a motor vehicle the possession of which was obtained before
- 8 that date is governed by the law in effect at the time possession
- 9 was obtained, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 10 purpose.
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
