## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the sale of distilled spirits to ultimate consumers by
- 3 the holder of a distiller's and rectifier's permit.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 14.05(a), (b), and (f), Alcoholic
- 6 Beverage Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) The holder of a distiller's and rectifier's permit whose
- 8 permitted premises is located in an area where the sale of alcoholic
- 9 beverages is legal as provided by a ballot issue approved by the
- 10 voters under Section 501.035(b)(7), (8), or (9), Election Code, may
- 11 sell to ultimate consumers for consumption on or off the permitted
- 12 premises distilled spirits manufactured or rectified by the permit
- 13 holder in an amount not to exceed 12,500 [3,000] gallons annually.
- 14 (b) The holder of a distiller's and rectifier's permit may
- 15 sell distilled spirits manufactured by the permit holder to
- 16 ultimate consumers for off-premises consumption in unbroken
- 17 packages containing not more than 750 milliliters of distilled
- 18 spirits for off-premises consumption [in an amount not to exceed
- 19 3,500 gallons annually] if:
- 20 (1) for a permit issued on or after September 1, 2013,
- 21 the permitted premises is located in an area where the sale of
- 22 alcoholic beverages is legal as provided by a ballot issue approved
- 23 by the voters under Section 501.035(b)(5), (6), or (7), Election

- 1 (2) for a permit issued before September 1, 2013, the
- 2 permitted premises is located in an area where the sale of alcoholic
- 3 beverages is legal as provided by a ballot issue approved by the
- 4 voters under Section 501.035(b)(5), (6), (7), (8), or (9), Election
- 5 Code.
- 6 (f) The permit holder must [check a purchaser's
- 7 identification and keep records of sales [purchases] in a manner
- 8 that enables the permit holder to comply with this section.
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 14.05(c), Alcoholic Beverage Code, is
- 10 repealed.
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
