AN ACT

- 2 relating to publication and posting of notice by governmental
- 3 entities and representatives.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. The heading to Subchapter C, Chapter 2051,
- 6 Government Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 SUBCHAPTER C. NOTICE BY PUBLICATION IN NEWSPAPER; INTERNET
- 8 ALTERNATIVE
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 2051.041(3), Government Code, is amended
- 10 to read as follows:

- 11 (3) "Notice" means any matter, including a
- 12 proclamation or advertisement, required or authorized by law to be
- 13 posted publicly [published in a newspaper] by a governmental entity
- 14 or representative.
- 15 SECTION 3. The heading to Section 2051.042, Government
- 16 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 17 Sec. 2051.042. [APPLICABILITY OF] SUBCHAPTER APPLICABLE TO
- 18 NEWSPAPER NOTICE REQUIRED BY OTHER LAW.
- 19 SECTION 4. Section 2051.042(a), Government Code, is amended
- 20 to read as follows:
- 21 (a) This subchapter applies:
- 22 (1) only to notice that is required or authorized by
- 23 law other than this subchapter to be published in a newspaper; and
- 24 (2) only to the extent that the other [general or

- 1 special law [requiring or authorizing the publication of a notice
- 2 in a newspaper by a governmental entity or representative] does not
- 3 specify the manner of the publication, including the number of
- 4 times that the notice is required to be published and the period
- 5 during which the notice is required to be published.
- 6 SECTION 5. Subchapter C, Chapter 2051, Government Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 2051.0421 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 2051.0421. INTERNET POSTING ALTERNATIVE FOR NOTICE
- 9 REQUIRED TO BE PUBLISHED IN NEWSPAPER. (a) Notwithstanding any
- 10 other law and except as provided by Section 2051.042(b), a
- 11 governmental entity or representative required by other law to
- 12 provide notice by publication in a newspaper may, as an
- 13 alternative, satisfy that requirement by posting the notice on the
- 14 governmental entity's or representative's Internet website.
- 15 (b) Internet website notice posted as an alternative to
- 16 required publication of notice in a newspaper as authorized by this
- 17 section:
- 18 (1) to the extent possible, must meet requirements
- 19 provided by law for the publication of the newspaper notice that can
- 20 be applied to an Internet website posting, including requirements
- 21 related to the timing, duration, content, and appearance of the
- 22 <u>notice; and</u>
- 23 (2) is not required to meet requirements provided by
- 24 law for the publication of the newspaper notice that by their nature
- 25 cannot be applied to an Internet website posting, including
- 26 requirements relating to circulation.
- 27 (c) This subchapter may not be construed to require a

- 1 governmental entity or representative that chooses the alternative
- 2 Internet posting under this section to also publish notice in a
- 3 <u>newspaper</u>.
- 4 SECTION 6. Section 2051.043, Government Code, is amended to
- 5 read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 2051.043. PUBLICATION IN AT LEAST ONE ISSUE REQUIRED.
- 7 A [Except as provided by Section 2051.046(b) or 2051.048(d), a]
- 8 notice <u>published in a newspaper</u> shall be published in at least one
- 9 issue of a newspaper.
- SECTION 7. Section 2051.044(a), Government Code, is amended
- 11 to read as follows:
- 12 (a) To be eligible for the publication of notice, a [The]
- 13 newspaper [in which a notice is published] must:
- 14 (1) devote not less than 25 percent of its total column
- 15 lineage to general interest items;
- 16 (2) be published at least once each week;
- 17 (3) be entered as second-class postal matter in the
- 18 county where published; and
- 19 (4) have been published regularly and continuously for
- 20 at least 12 months before the governmental entity or representative
- 21 publishes notice.
- SECTION 8. Section 2051.0441(b), Government Code, is
- 23 amended to read as follows:
- 24 (b) To be eligible for the publication of notice under this
- 25 section, the [The] newspaper [in which a notice is published under
- 26 this section must:
- 27 (1) devote not less than 20 percent of its total column

- 1 lineage to general interest items;
- 2 (2) be published at least once each week;
- 3 (3) be entered as periodical postal matter in the
- 4 county where published or have a mailed or delivered circulation of
- 5 at least 51 percent of the residences in the county where published;
- 6 and
- 7 (4) have been published regularly and continuously for
- 8 at least 12 months before the governmental entity or representative
- 9 publishes notice.
- SECTION 9. Sections 2051.046(a) and (b), Government Code,
- 11 are amended to read as follows:
- 12 (a) A [notice of a] county may contract for publication of
- 13 newspaper notice only with [shall be published in] a newspaper
- 14 published in the county that will publish the notice at or below the
- 15 legal rate.
- 16 (b) If no newspaper that will publish the notice at or below
- 17 the legal rate is published in the county, the notice shall be
- 18 posted:
- 19 (1) at the door of the county courthouse; or
- 20 (2) on the governmental entity's or representative's
- 21 Internet website, as authorized by Section 2051.0421.
- SECTION 10. Sections 2051.048(b) and (d), Government Code,
- 23 are amended to read as follows:
- 24 (b) A [notice of a] political subdivision may contract for
- 25 the publication of newspaper notice only with [shall be published
- $26 \frac{in}{n}$] a newspaper that is published in the political subdivision and
- 27 that will publish the notice at or below the legal rate.

- 1 (d) If no newspaper published in the county in which the
- 2 political subdivision is located will publish the notice at or
- 3 below the legal rate, the political subdivision shall post the
- 4 notice:
- 5 (1) at the door of the county courthouse of the county
- 6 in which the political subdivision is located; or
- 7 (2) on the governmental entity's or representative's
- 8 Internet website, as authorized by Section 2051.0421.
- 9 SECTION 11. Section 2051.049, Government Code, is amended
- 10 to read as follows:
- 11 Sec. 2051.049. SELECTION OF NEWSPAPER. A [The]
- 12 governmental entity or representative that publishes [required to
- 13 publish] a notice in a newspaper shall select, in accordance with
- 14 this subchapter, one or more newspapers to publish the notice.
- 15 SECTION 12. Section 2051.050, Government Code, is amended
- 16 to read as follows:
- Sec. 2051.050. TIME OF PUBLICATION. (a) A notice must be
- 18 published in a newspaper issued at least one day before the
- 19 occurrence of the event to which the notice refers.
- 20 (b) A notice posted on a governmental entity's or
- 21 representative's Internet website as an alternative to required
- 22 <u>newspaper notice under Section 2051.0421 must be posted at least</u>
- 23 one day before the occurrence of the event to which the notice
- 24 <u>refers.</u>
- 25 SECTION 13. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
