5	SECTION 1. Section 502.198(a), Transportation Code, is
6	amended to read as follows:
7	(a) Except as provided by Sections 502.058, 502.060,
8	502.1911, 502.192, <u>502.1981</u> , 502.356, and 502.357 and Subchapter H,
9	this section applies to all fees collected by a county
10	assessor-collector under this chapter.
11	SECTION 2. Subchapter E, Chapter 502, Transportation Code,
12	is amended by adding Section 502.1981 to read as follows:
13	Sec. 502.1981. DISPOSITION OF CERTAIN FEES. (a) This
14	subsection applies only to a vehicle for which registration is
15	applied for under Section 501.0234 in the county in which the owner
16	is domiciled. Each Tuesday, a county assessor-collector shall:
17	(1) credit to the county road and bridge fund \$25 of
18	each fee collected during the preceding week for registration of a
19	vehicle described by this subsection; and
20	(2) send the remainder of the amount collected to the
21	department for deposit to the credit of the state highway fund.

- 18 502.1981(a) in an interest-bearing account or certificate in the
- 19 county depository; and
- 20 (2) send the fees to the department not later than the
- 21 34th day after the date the fees are due under Section 502.198 or
- 22 <u>502.1981(a)</u>, as applicable.
- SECTION 4. Subchapter H, Chapter 502, Transportation Code,
- 24 is amended by adding Section 502.4035 to read as follows:
- Sec. 502.4035. IMPOSITION OF OPTIONAL COUNTY FEE ON CERTAIN
- 26 VEHICLES PROHIBITED. (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of
- 27 this subchapter, an additional fee authorized by a county under

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- 1 this subchapter, including an additional fee authorized under
- 2 <u>Section 502.401, 502.402, or 502.403, may not be imposed on a</u>
- 3 vehicle for which registration is applied for under Section
- 4 501.0234.
- 5 (b) This section does not apply to the renewal of
- 6 registration of a vehicle described by Subsection (a).
- 7 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
