- 6 SECTION 1. Chapter 103, Occupations Code, is amended by
- adding Section 103.0015 to read as follows: 7
- Sec. 103.0015. OPT IN REQUIRED. (a) A physician, nurse, 8
- 9 staff member, or employee of a hospital or other health care
- facility or a student, intern, or resident at an educational 10
- institution may not be scheduled for or assigned to duties 11
- 12 involving directly or indirectly performing or participating in an
- abortion procedure unless the physician, nurse, staff member, 13
- 14 employee, student, intern, or resident first affirmatively
- consents to perform or participate in the procedure. 15
- 16 (b) This section may not be construed to prohibit a student,
- intern, or resident from attending or viewing or a hospital, health 17
- care facility, or educational institution from providing lectures 18
- and course materials on the performance of an abortion. 19
- 20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
