- 2 relating to the appointment and removal of directors of a levee
- 3 improvement district; validating certain appointments and actions
- 4 of certain levee improvement districts.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 57.053, Water Code, is amended to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 Sec. 57.053. VACANCY AND [TERM OF OFFICE,] REMOVAL[, AND
- 9 SUCCESSION]. (a) A vacancy on an appointed [the] board is [shall
- 10 be filled by the appointment of a director by a majority vote of
- 11 the commissioners court. A director appointed to fill a vacancy
- 12 <u>must be a person qualified for election as a director under Section</u>
- 13 <u>57.059</u>. The commissioners[, and the] court shall appoint directors
- 14 so that the board will always have full membership.
- 15 (b) The commissioners court, by majority vote, may remove a
- 16 director who was appointed by the commissioners court [an appointed
- 17 member of the board].
- 18 <u>(c)</u> A vacancy on an elected board is filled in accordance
- 19 with Section 49.105.
- 20 SECTION 2. (a) The changes in law made by this Act apply
- 21 only to the board of directors of a levee improvement district
- 22 governed by Chapter 57, Water Code, in relation to a vacancy on the
- 23 board filled, or the removal of a director, that occurs on or after
- 24 the effective date of this Act. A vacancy filled or removal of a

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- 1 director before the effective date of this Act is governed by the
- 2 law in effect on the date the vacancy was filled or the director was
- 3 removed.
- 4 (b) The filling of a vacancy on the board of directors of a
- 5 levee improvement district governed by Chapter 57, Water Code, that
- 6 occurred before the effective date of this Act and that was
- 7 accomplished in accordance with Section 49.105, Water Code, is
- 8 ratified, confirmed, and validated and all governmental acts and
- 9 proceedings of a board of directors affected by the validation that
- 10 occurred before the effective date of this Act are validated for all
- 11 purposes.
- 12 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 13 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 14 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 15 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 16 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
