- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 57.053, Water Code, is amended to read as
- 6 follows:
- 7 Sec. 57.053. [TERM OF OFFICE] VACANCY, REMOVAL, AND
- 8 SUCCESSION. (a) In districts which have appointed boards, a [A]
- 9 vacancy on the board shall be filled by majority vote of the
- 10 commissioners court, and the court shall appoint directors so that
- 11 the board will always have full membership.
- 12 (b) The commissioners court, by majority vote, may remove \underline{a}
- 13 [an appointed] member of the board previously appointed by the
- 14 commissioners court.
- 15 (c) In districts which have elected boards, a vacancy on the
- 16 board shall be filled in accordance with Section 49.105. The board
- 17 may only appoint a director that is qualified for election as a
- 18 director under Section 57.059.
- 19 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 20 a vacancy filled on or after the effective date of this Act. A
- 21 vacancy filled before the effective date of this Act is governed by
- 22 the law in effect on the date the vacancy was filled, provided that
- 23 any vacancy filled before the effective date of this Act in
- 24 accordance with Section 49.105, Water Code, may be ratified,

- 1 confirmed and validated by the board after the effective date of
- 2 this Act and, upon such ratification, confirmation and validation
- 3 of all governmental acts and proceedings of the board occurring
- 4 before the effective date of this Act shall be ratified, confirmed
- 5 and validated for all purposes.
- 6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 7 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 10 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
