SECTION 1. Section 1355.015, Insurance Code, is amended by 4

- (a-1) At a minimum, a health benefit plan must provide 7
- coverage for treatment of autism spectrum disorder as provided by 8
- 9 this section to an enrollee who is diagnosed with autism spectrum
- disorder from the date of diagnosis, only if the diagnosis was in 10
- place prior to the enrollee's 22nd [child's 10th] birthday. 11
- 12 (c-1) The health benefit plan may [is] not require [required
- to provide coverage under Subsection (b) for benefits for] an 13
- enrollee to be evaluated for autism spectrum disorder more than 14
- once every 10 years [of age or older for applied behavior analysis 15
- 16 in an amount that exceeds \$36,000 per year].
- (c-2) The health benefit plan may not prohibit or place a 17
- limitation on a health care practitioner described by Subsection 18
- (b)(1) from performing an evaluation requested by the plan's 19
- 20 issuer.
- 21 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- to a health benefit plan delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed 22
- 23 on or after January 1, 2022. A health benefit plan delivered,
- issued for delivery, or renewed before January 1, 2022, is governed 24
