## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 843, Insurance Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 843.212 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 843.212. PHYSICAL THERAPIST COPAYMENT LIMIT. A health
- 9 care plan that requires an enrollee to pay a copayment for an office
- 10 visit with the enrollee's primary care physician or provider may
- 11 not charge a higher copayment amount to that enrollee for an office
- 12 visit with a physical therapist.
- 13 SECTION 2. Subchapter D, Chapter 1301, Insurance Code, is
- 14 amended by adding Section 1301.166 to read as follows:
- 15 Sec. 1301.166. PHYSICAL THERAPIST COPAYMENT LIMIT. A
- 16 preferred provider benefit plan that requires an insured to pay a
- 17 copayment for an office visit with the insured's primary care
- 18 physician or provider may not charge a higher copayment amount to
- 19 that insured for an office visit with a physical therapist.
- SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 21 a health benefit plan delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed on
- 22 or after January 1, 2022.
- 23 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
